## **PREPARING YOUR GRAPHIC FILES**






Dimensions shown are at 100% scale.

The final PDF art file you submit to us must measure EXACTLY 2976 mm wide x 2415 mm high

When building your art files the instructions below must be followed EXACTLY. Failure to follow any of these instructions may result in delays and/or additional charges:

- Acceptable file formats for all SEG fabric graphic orders: **High-Resolution PDF only.**
- Design your graphic at 100% scale using the dimensions provided. (These dimensions already include bleed. DO NOT ADD ANY ADDITIONAL BLEED).
- PLEASE DO NOT USE CROP MARKS. BLEED MARKS. REGISTRATION MARKS OR ANY OTHER PRINTER MARKS.
- Use CMYK color space. If color matching is critical to your design, see important notes below.
- Resolution should be between 90 ppi minimum and 150 ppi MAXIMUM (36 60 pixels per cm). Please check the actual resolution of your files before uploading them. The best way to do this is to open each of your files, set your zoom level to 100% and scroll around the entire image area to see how the image will look when printed. See Fig. 1 below. If the file looks blurry or pixelated on your screen at 100%, it WILL print that way.
- Convert all type to outlines and embed all linked content.
- Maintain a 4 inch (100 mm) "Safe Zone" around the perimeter of your design. Keep all important elements such as text and small logos at least 4 inches (100 mm) away from the edges of the document.
- If ordering more than one graphic, provide a separate file for each graphic ordered. Note: image alignment across two or more contiguous SEG displays is not guaranteed. The nature of these displays involves stretching the fabric print, making alignment between multiple displays difficult to impossible. Please keep this in mind when designing your graphics.
- Place completed art files in one ZIP folder and upload them to us by clicking on the following link: https://www.hightail.com/u/ArtCraftSigns (there is no charge or sign-up required to use this service).



Colors: It is important to note that our large format printers do not use Pantone inks. All graphic prints are made using a process color printing system similar to your home computer's inkjet printer. Most specified PMS colors will be close, but may not be exact matches. If you require color matching services, contact us right away. Note: there will be an extra charge for color-matching services and turn-around times will generally increase by 4-6 additional business days.
